



# North Nahanni Naturalist Lodge

## Package One: Nahanni by Air, Land and Water

5 Nights

This unique and exciting North Nahanni Naturalist Lodge package includes Nahanni National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, as well as the greater Nahanni ecosystem via three modes of transportation; Air, Land and Water.

*\*Transportation to and from Fort Simpson, the lodge and Park tour is not included. These prices and the size of aircraft will be determined at time of booking. The type of aircraft is dependent on number of guests for each tour date and therefore different types of aircraft will be chartered to suit the group's needs, for example, a Cessna for small groups and Beaver or Twin Otter for larger groups.*

## DAY 1 SUNDAY

### Arrive in Fort Simpson/ Overnight in Cottage



Guests will arrive in Fort Simpson by First Air and Air Canada on regular scheduled flights.

Upon arrival guests will be welcomed by lodge staff for transportation and a historical tour of Fort Simpson, the oldest trading post along the Mackenzie River. Visitors overnight in executive style self serve log cottage or executive suites in Fort Simpson.

## DAY 2 MONDAY

### Virginia Falls Tour /Lodge Accommodations



After breakfast guests will fly to majestic Virginia Falls by a Cessna floatplane for an air and ground tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Itinerary for the day will include a two hour stop at Virginia Falls for hiking and photo opportunities as well as an air tour of the Ram Plateau, Dead Man Valley and all the way through the four incredible canyons of the South Nahanni River. Your day and adventure will conclude at North Nahanni Naturalist Lodge where guests will enjoy a fresh home cooked meal, hot shower and comfortable bed.

## DAY 3 TUESDAY

### Lodge based activities/Lodge Accommodations



A full day of guided lodge based activities. Your day will begin with a guided boat tour of Cli Lake with an explanation of the geological and historical significance of the area to the Dene people and Parks Canada. Visit a trapper's cabin, and try fishing or setting a net in the lake with a native guide. Guided hikes are available. There are native crafts, berry picking, a traditional teepee and a cultural area for demonstrations. Relax in the sauna or hot tub, canoe on the lake or relax and enjoy the beautiful scenery.

## DAY 4 WEDNESDAY

### Lodge based activities or Heli-Hiking Option/ Lodge Accommodations



Choose a full day of lodge based activities as in Day 3, or include a full day of heli-hiking from the lodge. The heli-hiking tour includes approximately two hours flight time, with shuttles if required for larger groups. Cost is split between the number of guests taking this extra special heli-tour. A Bell 206LR Long Range helicopter will pick guests up at the lodge after breakfast. Flight departs Cli Lake for Nahanni National Park. View the Ram Plateau and Canyons, Nahanni Karst, Death Lake and Igloo Cave. Tour includes stops at each location for photography and hiking. Enjoy a bag lunch atop the Ram Plateau. Many opportunities to see wildlife; mountain goats, dall sheep, mountain caribou, moose, black or grizzly bears. Explore and hike the majestic Ram Plateau, "Canada's Grand Canyon" Wind down at the lodge with a hot meal and lodge activities after the "Wow" experience of a lifetime.



## DAY 5 THURSDAY

### Jet Boat Tour/ Cottage Accommodations

Return to Fort Simpson either by optional air travel, or by jet boat on the river system. The jet boat option to Fort Simpson travels the Mackenzie, North Nahanni and Tetcela rivers. Package includes a one hour hike and a 15 minute boat ride from the lodge to the jet boat launch point. A shore lunch will be provided. There are hiking and photo opportunities and guests may see wildlife. Visit traditional aboriginal homesteads. Stay in a comfortable cottage or executive style suite while in Fort Simpson, overnight.

## DAY 6 FRIDAY

### Depart Fort Simpson

Guests depart from Fort Simpson on the regularly scheduled flight. Transportation to the airport is provided. Accommodations retail price: \$2000/person, A minimum number of guests is required for each scheduled tour date.

### OPTIONAL EXTRAS:

Helicopter tour is extra, cost to be determined. Hourly rate plus fuel, approximately \$4875, shared between up to six passengers.

Package may be modified by extending the initial air tour to include Glacier Lake. Glacier Lake flight additional cost: \$680 or \$170/person (estimate, prices may change, verified at time of booking)

Jet boat transportation can be provided for some package dates and is dependent on water levels, time of year and number of guests requesting this option.
