This exciting weekend North Nahanni Naturalist Lodge package is an all-inclusive four day and night package exploring Nahanni National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the greater Nahanni ecosystem by three modes of transportation; Air, Land and Water.

**Transportation to and from Fort Simpson, the lodge and Park tour is not included. These prices and the size of aircraft will be determined at time of booking. The type of aircraft is dependent on number of guests for each tour date and therefore different types of aircraft will be chartered to suit the group's needs, for example, a Cessna for small groups and Beaver or Twin Otter for larger groups..*

DAY 1 FRIDAY

Arrive in Fort Simpson/ Overnight in Cottage



Arrive in Fort Simpson with First Air and Air Canada on regular scheduled flights. Pick up at airport by lodge staff, transportation and historical tour of Fort Simpson, oldest trading post along the Mackenzie River. Guests overnight in executive style self serve log cottage or executive style suite in Fort Simpson.

DAY 2 SATURDAY

Virginia Falls Tour/Lodge Accommodations



After breakfast, fly to majestic Virginia Falls by Cessna floatplane for an air and ground tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Your day includes a two hour stop at the falls for hiking and photo opportunities, and a bag lunch. Fly over the Ram Plateau, Dead Man Valley and the four incredible canyons of the South Nahanni River. Your day of adventure winds down at your destination, North Nahanni Naturalist Lodge.

DAY 3 SUNDAY

Lodge based activities/Lodge Accommodations



A full day of guided lodge based activities. Your day starts with a guided boat tour of Cli Lake with an explanation of the geological and historical significance of area to the Dene people. Visit a trapper's cabin, try fishing or setting a net in the lake with a native guide. Guided hikes are available, as well as native crafts, berry picking, a traditional teepee and a cultural area for demonstrations. Relax in the lodge sauna or hot tub, canoe on the lake.

DAY 4 MONDAY

Jet Boat Tour/ Cottage Accommodations



Travel by jet boat to Fort Simpson along the Mackenzie, North Nahanni and Tetcela rivers.

Package includes a one hour hike and a 15 minute boat ride from the lodge to the jet boat launch point. A shore lunch will be provided and there are hiking opportunities. There are many photo opportunities and opportunities to see wildlife and traditional aboriginal homesteads. Overnight in your cottage at Fort Simpson.



DAY 5 TUESDAY

Depart Fort Simpson

Depart Fort Simpson on regularly scheduled flight. Transportation to the airport is provided.

Package Retail Price: \$1500/person. A minimum number of guests is required for each scheduled tour date.



OPTIONS:

Package may be modified by extending the initial air tour to include Glacier Lake. Glacier Lake flight additional cost: \$680 or \$170/person (estimate, prices may change, verified at time of booking)

Jet boat transportation can be provided for some package dates and is dependent on water levels, time of year and number of guests requesting this option.

Package does not include meals in Fort Simpson.
